AN ACT

- 1 Providing for an inventory of State-owned assets for the
- 2 development of mobile broadband services in unserved areas
- and underserved areas of this Commonwealth.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the State-owned
- 8 Assets and Mobile Broadband Services Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Department." The Department of General Services of the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 "Fixed broadband services." An Internet connection provided
- 16 through a link to a stationary location at a data bit rate or <--
- 17 connectivity speed defined by department policy.

- 1 "Mobile broadband services." An Internet connection provided
- 2 through a link to locations that are not stationary at a data <--
- 3 bit rate or connectivity speed defined by department policy.
- 4 "Qualified provider." A provider of mobile broadband service
- 5 that has obtained all governmental approvals required for the
- 6 provision of mobile broadband service in the unserved area or
- 7 underserved area in which it seeks to provide the service.
- 8 "Secretary." The Secretary of General Services of the
- 9 Commonwealth.
- 10 "Underserved area." An area within this Commonwealth that is
- 11 demonstrated to have limited access to fixed broadband services
- 12 or mobile broadband services.
- "Unserved area." An area within this Commonwealth that is
- 14 demonstrated to not have access to fixed broadband services or
- 15 mobile broadband service.
- 16 Section 3. Inventory of State-owned assets.
- 17 Under the act of June 15, 1972 (P.L.395, No.117), entitled
- 18 "An act providing for an inventory of all Commonwealth real
- 19 property, except highway rights-of-way to be prepared by the
- 20 Department of Property and Supplies, for its availability to the
- 21 public, for its updating, and for cooperation by all State
- 22 governmental agencies; and making an appropriation," and section
- 23 508(b) of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as
- 24 The Administrative Code of 1929, the department shall include in
- 25 its inventories and surveys of real estate structures and assets
- 26 information on possible use of those assets for fixed broadband
- 27 services or mobile broadband services. The information shall be
- 28 used by the department or its designee when analyzing resources
- 29 available in providing broadband services in underserved areas
- 30 and unserved areas.

- 1 Section 4. Lease or conveyance of State-owned assets.
- 2 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any provision of law to
- 3 the contrary and subject to the guidelines adopted by the
- 4 department under section 5, the department having responsibility
- 5 for a State-owned asset in an unserved area or underserved area
- 6 may lease or convey a license or other interest in the asset to
- 7 a qualified provider in order to permit the use of the asset by
- 8 the qualified provider in its deployment of mobile broadband
- 9 service within the unserved area or underserved area or portion
- 10 of that unserved area or underserved area.
- 11 (b) Evidence of compliance. -- The requirement under
- 12 subsection (a) is subject to the qualified provider presenting
- 13 to the department evidence of compliance with structural,
- 14 permitting and other guidelines under section 5, which will be
- 15 reviewed by the department or its designee.
- 16 Section 5. Departmental guidelines.
- 17 The department or its designee shall adopt guidelines for the
- 18 following:
- 19 (1) Qualifications for broadband service providers.
- 20 (2) Negotiating and finalizing site occupancy
- 21 agreements.
- 22 Section 6. Approvals.
- 23 The department or its designee shall identify an appropriate
- 24 timeline of no more than $\frac{30}{90}$ 90 days for approval of site
- 25 occupancy agreements.
- 26 SECTION 7. APPLICABILITY.
- 27 THIS ACT SHALL NOT APPLY TO:
- 28 (1) THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE.
- 29 (2) THE PENNSYLVANIA HISTORICAL AND MUSEUM COMMISSION.
- 30 Section 7 8. Effective date.

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1 This act shall take effect immediately.
