## AN ACT

Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act providing for access to public information, for a designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 5 6 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related 7 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in 9 procedure, further providing for exceptions for public 10 11 records. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 Section 1. Section 708(b)(6)(i)(A) of the act of February 15 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended to read: 16 17 Section 708. Exceptions for public records. \* \* \* 18 (b) Exceptions. -- Except as provided in subsections (c) and 19 20 (d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under
