AN ACT

Amending the act of May 11, 1889 (P.L.188, No.210), entitled "A further supplement to an act, entitled 'An act to establish a 2 board of wardens for the Port of Philadelphia, and for the 3 regulation of pilots and pilotage, and for other purposes,' approved March twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and 5 three, and for regulating the rates of pilotage and number of 6 pilots," further providing for rates of pilotage and computation, for pilotage fees and unit charge and for 7 8 charges for services. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 11 12 Section 1. Sections 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3 of the act of May 11, 1889 (P.L.188, No.210), entitled "A further supplement to an 13 14 act, entitled 'A further supplement to establish a board of 15 wardens for the Port of Philadelphia, and for the regulation of pilots and pilotage, and for other purposes, 'approved March 16 17 twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and three, and for 18 regulating the rates of pilotage and number of pilots," are 19 amended to read: 20 Section 3.1. For services rendered on and after January 1,

1990, retroactively, the rates of pilotage for conducting a

- 10 Section 3.2. That every ship or vessel bound to the Delaware
- 11 breakwater for orders shall be obliged to receive a pilot,
- 12 provided she is spoken or a pilot offers his services, outside
- 13 of a straight line drawn from Cape Henlopen Light to Cape May
- 14 Light, and every ship or vessel bound to the breakwater for
- 15 orders shall pay pilotage fees as follows: A sum equal to half
- 16 the pilotage to the Port of Philadelphia, and she shall be
- 17 obliged to take a pilot and pay the same pilotage fees when
- 18 outward bound, from the breakwater, and if such ship or vessel,
- 19 without discharging her pilot, proceed to the Port of
- 20 Philadelphia or any other port or place on the bay or river
- 21 Delaware, only one full pilotage fee as fixed by section 3.1 of
- 22 this act, for the entire service, in addition to the fee for
- 23 detention: Provided, however, That if the pilot bringing such
- 24 ship or vessel to the breakwater be there discharged, and the
- 25 ship or vessel afterward proceed to Philadelphia or any other
- 26 port or place on the bay or river Delaware, she shall make the
- 27 usual signal for a pilot and continue to make such signal till
- 28 reaching Brandywine Light, and if spoken by, or offered the
- 29 services of, a duly licensed Pennsylvania pilot before reaching
- 30 Brandywine Light, shall be obliged to employ such pilot and pay

14	All piers south of the above - 3 hours before sailing time.	
15	(6) Finance charge:	
16	A finance charge not to exceed one and one-half per centum per	
17	month or fraction thereof may be assessed against all invoices	
18	outstanding more than thirty days after the billing date, and	
19	the cost of attorney fees on any amount placed with an attorney	
20	for collection may also be charged.	
21	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
