- 13 The Pennsylvania Dairy Future Commission is established.
- 14 § 904. Duties.
- The commission shall review and make recommendations to
- 16 promote and strengthen the Commonwealth's dairy industry in the
- 17 following areas:
- 18 <u>(1) Processing, production and marketing in the dairy</u>
- 19 industry.
- 20 (2) Current issues facing the dairy industry.
- 21 (3) Statutory impacts on the dairy industry.
- 22 (4) Regulatory impacts on the dairy industry.
- 23 (5) Local government impacts on the dairy industry.
- 24 (6) Other aspects of the dairy industry identified by
- 25 the commission.
- 26 § 905. Membership.
- 27 (a) General rule. -- The commission shall consist of the
- 28 following members:
- 29 <u>(1) One individual appointed by the Governor.</u>
- 30 (2) The Secretary of Agriculture or a designee.

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| or a designee. |
| (4) The Secretary of Revenue or a designee. |
| (5) The Secretary of Transportation or a designee. |
| (6) The Secretary of Environmental Protection or a |

| (7) One individual approved by the President pro tempore |

| (8) One individual appointed by the Speaker of the House |
| of Representatives. |
| (9) Two individuals appointed by the Majority Leader of |

- 4 (b) Chairperson. -- The commission shall appoint a member to
- 5 <u>serve as chairperson of the commission.</u>
- 6 § 906. Meetings.
- 7 The commission shall hold its first meeting within 45 days of
- 8 the effective date of this section, regardless of whether all
- 9 <u>legislative caucuses have appointed members to the commission.</u>
- 10 The commission shall hold meetings on the call of the
- 11 <u>chairperson</u>.
- 12 § 907. Payments to members.
- 13 Members may not receive compensation for services, but shall
- 14 be reimbursed for all necessary travel and other reasonable
- 15 expenses incurred in connection with the performance of the
- 16 members' duties as members of the commission.
- 17 § 908. Administrative support.
- 18 The Department of Agriculture shall provide administrative
- 19 support, meeting space and any other assistance required by the
- 20 commission to carry out the commission's duties under this
- 21 chapter. The department shall provide the commission with data,
- 22 research and other information upon request by the commission.
- 23 § 909. Additional powers and duties.
- 24 The commission shall have the following powers and duties:
- 25 (1) Review, make findings and offer recommendations
- 26 related to the dairy industry in this Commonwealth.
- 27 (2) Consult with and utilize experts to assist the
- commission in carrying out the duties under this subsection.
- 29 <u>(3) Receive input from interested parties.</u>
- 30 (4) Hold public hearings in different regions of this

- (6) Review the administration and operation of State and regional programs and services and make recommendations to implement new policies, legislation and regulations.
- 7 (7) Draft proposed legislation based on the commission's findings.
- 9 (8) Issue a report of the commission's findings and recommendations to the Governor, the Majority Leader and 10 Minority Leader of the Senate, the Majority Leader and 11 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, the Minority 12 Leader of the House of Representatives, the chairperson and 13 minority chairperson of the Agriculture and Rural Affairs 14 15 Committee of the Senate, the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee of 16 17 the House of Representatives not later than one year after
