## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.216 No.76), entitled "An act relating to dentistry; defining and providing for the 2 licensing and registration of dentists and dental hygienists, 3 and for the revocation and suspension of such licenses and registrations, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; defining the powers and duties of the State Dental Council and Examining Board and the Department of 7 Public Instruction; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," further providing for anesthesia and abrogating a regulation. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 11.2 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.216, 14 No.76), known as The Dental Law, is amended by adding a 15 subsection to read: \* \* \* 16 17 (q) The board shall not limit the eligibility of dentists to 18 use a hospital or other medical facility for anesthesia services 19 or to receive payment for services rendered at a hospital or 20 other medical facility.
- 21 Section 2. The regulation of the Department of Public

- 1 Welfare at 55 Pa. Code § 1150.52(e) (relating to anesthesia
- 2 services) is abrogated to the extent that the regulation is
- 3 inconsistent with this act.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
