AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing
- for parent educational information regarding eating
- 7 disorders.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 1426. Parent Educational Information Regarding</u>
- 14 Eating Disorders. -- (a) Each school entity shall annually
- 15 provide parent educational information regarding eating
- 16 disorders for pupils in grades six through twelve. The
- 17 <u>information shall be consistent with quidelines established</u>
- 18 under this section.
- 19 (b) Each school entity shall provide the annual parent
- 20 educational information to all parents and guardians via email,

- 1 <u>first class mail or on the school entity's publicly accessible</u>
- 2 Internet website.
- 3 (c) The following shall apply:
- 4 (1) The Department of Education, in conjunction with the
- 5 Department of Health, shall develop an Eating Disorders Task
- 6 Force that shall develop and implement quidelines for providing
- 7 parent educational information regarding eating disorders. The
- 8 <u>guidelines shall be developed with input from specialized</u>
- 9 organizations and entities, including boards of school
- 10 directors, school superintendents, the National Alliance for
- 11 Eating Disorders, the Pennsylvania Association of School Nurses
- 12 and Practitioners, the Pennsylvania Chapter of the American
- 13 Academy of Pediatrics, the Pennsylvania Academy of Family
- 14 Physicians, the International Association of Eating Disorders
- 15 Professionals Foundation and the Academy for Eating Disorders.
- 16 (2) The Eating Disorders Task Force shall meet at least two
- 17 times per school year to reassess the information provided to
- 18 schools and to parents. The task force shall meet at least once
- 19 prior to the school year beginning and shall meet at least once
- 20 in the beginning of the calendar year.
- 21 (d) The Department of Education, the Department of Health
- 22 and the Eating Disorders Task Force shall identify and develop
- 23 <u>appropriate additions or revisions to this Commonwealth's school</u>
- 24 health regulations and materials related to the development of
- 25 parent educational information, including guidance regarding the
- 26 clear delineation of health information from other
- 27 <u>administrative documentation</u>.
- 28 (e) The guidelines developed under this section shall
- 29 <u>include the following:</u>
- 30 (1) The development of a letter for key school personnel,

- 1 <u>including school principals</u>, vice principals and school
- 2 counselors and psychologists, on the importance of eating
- 3 <u>disorder prevention education and resources for schools.</u>
- 4 (2) The development of a letter to parents and guardians
- 5 that includes warning signs, risk factors, resources and other
- 6 <u>information about eating disorders</u>.
- 7 (f) As used in this section, the term "school entity" means
- 8 <u>an area career and technical school, a charter school, a cyber</u>
- 9 <u>charter school, an intermediate unit, a nonpublic school or a</u>
- 10 school district.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
