TITLE 75 IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ: 8 9 <u>§ 1358.2.</u> Distracted Driving Awareness plate. 10 (a) Distracted Driving Awareness plate. -- The department shall design a Distracted Driving Awareness registration plate. 11 12 Upon application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$40, 13 which shall be in addition to the registration fee, the 14 department shall issue the plate for a passenger car or truck 15 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds or 16 a motor home. The fee shall be used exclusively to advance public education and outreach on the dangers posed by distracted 17 18 driving, at the department's discretion. 19 (b) Expiration. -- This section shall expire December 31, 20 202<u>5.</u> 21 Section <del>2</del> 3.
