12	hereby enacts as follows:	
13	Section 1. The act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156),	
14	known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, is amended	
15	by adding sections A SECTION to read:	<
16	Section 301.2. Payment.	
17	(a) Methods	
18	(1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) and	
19	notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensed	
20	eligible organization may accept payment via credit card,	
21	debit card, mobile payment services or other electronic	

1	payment method for the playing of games of chance. PURCHASE <-
2	OF A RAFFLE TICKET, PROVIDED THAT THE ORGANIZATION:
3	(I) EMPLOYS A METHOD TO VERIFY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL
4	WHO BUYS A RAFFLE TICKET IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE. THE
5	ORGANIZATION MAY NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT FROM AN INDIVIDUAL
6	UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE; AND
7	(II) DOES NOT VIOLATE THE PROVISIONS OF 31 U.S.C.
8	CH. 53 SUBCH. IV (RELATING TO PROHIBITION ON FUNDING OF
9	UNLAWFUL INTERNET GAMBLING).
10	(2) A licensee under Chapter 9 may not accept mobile
11	payment services for the playing of games of chance.
12	(b) Definitions As used in this section, the following
13	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
14	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
15	"Mobile payment service." A service in which a money payment
16	is made electronically through a money transfer service., such
17	as Venmo, Paypal, Cash App or an equivalent money transfer
18	service.
19	Section 303.2. Online raffle sales.
20	(a) Operations. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
21	act, a licensed eligible organization may conduct and reveal the
22	winner of raffles through a publicly accessible Internet
23	website, social media platform or mobile application.
24	(b) Payments. A licensed eligible organization may accept
25	electronic payment via credit card, debit card, mobile
26	electronic payment application or other electronic payment
27	method for the purchase of a raffle ticket, provided that the
28	organization:
29	(1) employs a method to detect the physical location of
30	an individual who buys a ticket for the raffle. The

1 organization may not accept payment from an individual 2 located outside of this Commonwealth; (2) employs a method to verify that the individual who 3 buys a raffle ticket is at least 18 years of age. The 4 5 organization may not accept payment from an individual under 6 18 years of age; and (3) does not violate the provisions of 31 U.S.C. Ch. 53 7 8 Subch. IV (relating to prohibition on funding of unlawful 9 Internet gambling). (c) Applicability. The following sections shall not 10 to online raffle sales: 11 (1) Section 302. 12 (2) Section 303(b). 13 14 (3) Section 907. 15 Section 2. The provisions of 61 Pa. Code § 901.506 are abrogated insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition of 16 section 301.2 of the act. 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 18
