- 7 Section 4. State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers.
- 8 (a) Creation. -- There is hereby created the State Board of
- 9 Certified Real Estate Appraisers as a departmental
- 10 administrative board in the Department of State. The board shall
- 11 consist of the following members:
- 12 (1) The Secretary of the Commonwealth or a designee.
- 13 (2) The Attorney General or a designee.
- 14 (3) The Secretary of Banking or a designee.
- 15 (4) [Eight] <u>Ten</u> members who are citizens of the United
- 16 States and who have been residents of this Commonwealth for a
- 17 two-year period immediately prior to appointment[, two of
- whom shall be public members and six]. Six of [whom] the
- 19 <u>members</u> shall be persons who are State-certified real estate
- 20 appraisers[.], two of the members shall be persons who are
- 21 <u>certified Pennsylvania evaluators, and two of the members</u>
- 22 <u>shall be public members. Nothing shall prohibit the</u>
- appointment of a professional member who is a certified
- 24 <u>Pennsylvania evaluator and also a State-certified real estate</u>
- 25 <u>appraiser</u>, but the appointment shall specify in which
- 26 capacity the member is being appointed.
- 27 (b) Term of office.--The professional and public members
- 28 shall serve four-year terms, except as provided in subsection
- 29 (c) or (c.1), and shall be appointed by the Governor by and with
- 30 the advice and consent of a majority of the members elected to

- 3 (c.1) Initial appointments of certified Pennsylvania
- 4 <u>evaluators.--Within 90 days of the effective date of this</u>
