Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in contract clauses and preference provisions, 2 providing for solar photovoltaic technologies; and imposing 3 duties on the Auditor General, the Department of Community 4 and Economic Development and the Department of Environmental Protection. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Chapter 37 of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania 10 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read: 11 SUBCHAPTER F 12 SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC TECHNOLOGIES 13 Sec. § 3761. Contract provisions. 18 (a) Manufactured in the United States. -- A Commonwealth 19 agency shall require that a contract for the construction,

reconstruction, alteration, repair or improvement of public

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- 1 works contain a provision that, if a solar photovoltaic
- 2 <u>technology or component is to be used or supplied in the</u>
- 3 performance of the contract or a subcontract, only solar
- 4 photovoltaic technology or components manufactured and assembled
- 5 <u>in the United States shall be used or supplied.</u>
- 6 (b) Tax credits.--No tax credit awarded by a Commonwealth_
- 7 agency may be used for a project that utilizes a solar
- 8 photovoltaic technology or component manufactured or assembled
- 9 <u>outside of the United States.</u>
- 10 (c) Certify contracts. -- The Department of General Services,
- 11 in cooperation with the Department of Environmental Protection,
- 12 shall certify that contracts for the use of electricity or solar
- 13 <u>energy credits are awarded to entities that utilize solar</u>
- 14 photovoltaic technologies or components manufactured or
- 15 assembled in the United States.
- 16 (d) Regulations. -- The Department of Community and Economic
- 17 Development shall develop standards and quidelines to prohibit
- 18 Commonwealth funds from being expended on a contract that is
- 19 performed by the use or supply of solar photovoltaic technology
- 20 or components manufactured or assembled outside the United
- 21 States.
- 22 (e) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "public"
- 23 work" shall have the same meaning given to it in section 2(5) of
- 24 the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the
- 25 <u>Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act.</u>
- 26 § 3762. Reporting and study.
- 27 <u>(a) Auditor General.--The Auditor General shall submit to</u>
- 28 the chair and minority chair of the Environmental Resources and
- 29 Energy Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority chair
- 30 of the Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the House

- 1 of Representatives a report on the amount of solar photovoltaic
- 2 technologies procured by Commonwealth agencies within 120 days
- 3 after the effective date of this section.
- 4 (b) Department of Community and Economic Development. -- The
- 5 Department of Community and Economic Development shall conduct a
- 6 study of the domestic market of solar panel production and the
- 7 global supply chain and workforce involved in solar photovoltaic
- 8 technology production.
- 9 <u>(1) The report shall be completed by July 1, 2022.</u>
- 10 (2) The report shall be submitted to:
- 11 <u>(i) The President pro tempore of the Senate.</u>
- 12 <u>(ii) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.</u>
- 13 <u>(iii) The Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the</u>
- 14 <u>Senate.</u>
- 15 <u>(iv) The Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the</u>
- 16 <u>House of Representatives.</u>
- 17 <u>(v) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the</u>
- 18 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the
- 19 Senate.
- 20 (vi) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 21 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the House
- of Representatives.
- 23 <u>§ 3763. Recycling.</u>
- 24 The Department of Environmental Protection shall promulgate
- 25 regulations to develop a Statewide recycling program for solar
- 26 photovoltaic technology and components.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
