- Amending the act of November 29, 2006 (P.L.1463, No.163), entitled "An act providing for protection from identity 2 theft, for security freezes, for procedures for access after 3 imposition and removal of security freezes and for related 4 matters," further providing for security freeze. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 3(d) of the act of November 29, 2006 (P.L.1463, No.163), known as the Credit Reporting Agency Act, is 10 amended to read: 11 Section 3. Security freeze. 12 13 Duration of freeze. -- A security freeze shall remain in place until [the earlier of the date] the consumer reporting 14 15 agency receives a request from the consumer to remove the 16 security freeze [or until seven years from the date that the 17 security freeze was put in place by the consumer reporting 18 agency]. * * * 19
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
