## AN ACT

Amending the act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), entitled "An act providing for victims' rights; imposing 2 penalties; establishing remedies; establishing the Office of 3 Victim Advocate, the Bureau of Victims' Services, the Victims' Services Advisory Committee, the State Offender Supervision Fund and other funds; and making repeals," in 6 crime victims, further providing for responsibilities of State and local law enforcement agencies. 8 9 This act may be referred to as Tara's Law. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 212 of the act of November 24, 1998 13 (P.L.882, No.111), known as the Crime Victims Act, is amended by 14 adding a subsection to read: 15 Section 212. Responsibilities of State and local law 16 enforcement agencies. 17 18 (h) Release of identification. --19 (1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2), a law 20 enforcement agency shall make a reasonable effort to contact a surviving family member of a direct victim of murder or 21

- 1 <u>intervenor before publicly releasing the identification of</u>
- 2 <u>the direct victim or intervenor.</u>
- 3 (2) A law enforcement agency may publicly release the
- 4 <u>identification of a direct victim of murder or intervenor</u>
- 5 without notification of the death to a surviving family
- 6 member if the release is necessary for the investigation of
- 7 the murder.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
