A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the month of September 2023 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, More than 19,000 women will receive a new diagnosis
4	of ovarian cancer in 2023; and
5	WHEREAS, More than 13,000 women will die from ovarian cancer
6	in 2023; and
7	WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer ranks fifth in cancer deaths among
8	women, accounting for more deaths than any other cancer of the
9	female reproductive system; and
10	WHEREAS, A woman's risk of getting ovarian cancer during her
11	lifetime is about 1 in 78, and her lifetime chance of dying from
12	ovarian cancer is about 1 in 108; and
13	WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer often goes undetected until it has
14	reached advanced stages; and
15	WHEREAS, According to the National Cancer Institute, ovarian
16	cancer may not cause early signs or symptoms and it is difficult
17	to screen for the disease; and

WHEREAS, Many Pennsylvanians and their families have been
struck with this terrible disease; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of September
2023 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania; and be
