A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of October 2021 as "National Disability Employment Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "National Disability Employment Awareness Month" is
- 4 observed in October each year; and
- 5 WHEREAS, During "National Disability Employment Awareness
- 6 Month," a nationwide campaign raises awareness about disability
- 7 employment issues and honors the many contributions of America's
- 8 workers with disabilities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The observance of "National Disability Employment
- 10 Awareness Month" promotes positive employment outcomes for
- 11 people with disabilities and endeavors to expand ideas about
- 12 what youth with disabilities can achieve when they receive
- 13 encouragement and support for their ambitions; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The aim this month is to inspire workplaces to build
- 15 an inclusive community; and
- 16 WHEREAS, "National Disability Employment Awareness Month"
- 17 traces its history to 1945, when Congress declared the first

- 1 week in October each year to be "National Employ the Physically
- 2 Handicapped Week"; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In 1954, Congress directed the President's Committee
- 4 on National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week to work with
- 5 state and local authorities to promote job opportunities for the
- 6 physically handicapped; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In 1962, the word "physically" was removed to
- 8 acknowledge the needs and contributions of individuals with all
- 9 types of disabilities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 1988, Congress expanded the week to a month and
- 11 adopted its current name; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Thirty-one years after the signing of the Americans
- 13 with Disabilities Act, great progress has been made in removing
- 14 barriers to employment for those with disabilities, yet further
- 15 opportunities for progress exist; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The theme for this year, which marks 76 years since
- 17 the first observance of "National Employ the Physically
- 18 Handicapped Week," is "America's Recovery: Powered by
- 19 Inclusion"; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The theme was selected by the United States
- 21 Department of Labor's Office of Disability Employment Policy to
- 22 emphasize that people with disabilities have full access to
- 23 employment and community involvement during the recovery from
- 24 the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- 25 WHEREAS, "National Disability Employment Awareness Month"
- 26 coincides with the national celebration of "Disability History
- 27 Month"; therefore be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of October 2021
- 29 as "National Disability Employment Awareness Month" in
- 30 Pennsylvania.
