A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of September 2019 as "National Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Seventeen thousand spinal cord injuries occur in the
- 4 United States each year; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Approximately 300,000 Americans, including 40,000
- 6 veterans, have spinal cord injuries; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Spinal cord injuries often result in paralysis of
- 8 either the lower body, paraplegia, or the upper and lower body,
- 9 quadriplegia, and often can cause respiratory illness, sleep
- 10 apnea, a form of high blood pressure known as autonomic
- 11 dysreflexia, inability to regulate body temperature, chronic
- 12 pain and impaired use of bladder, bowel and reproductive organs;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, Spinal cord injury may increase an individual's risk
- 15 for osteoporosis, obesity, high cholesterol and diabetes, making
- 16 physical activity especially important to the physical and
- 17 emotional well-being of individuals with spinal cord injuries;

- 2 WHEREAS, Every 48 minutes another individual in the United
- 3 States becomes paralyzed from a spinal cord injury; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Senate affirms the necessity of addressing
- 5 spinal cord injuries and the particular challenges of spinal
- 6 cord injury care and recovery for individuals with new or
- 7 existing injuries and for their loved ones and caregivers; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Senate further notes the significance of
- 9 ensuring access to related resources and benefits, advancing
- 10 medical research and disseminating public education and
- 11 outreach; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "National Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Month" offers
- 13 an opportunity for individuals to learn about spinal cord
- 14 injuries, recognize the daily challenges encountered by injured
- 15 individuals and acknowledge the achievements of Americans living
- 16 with spinal cord injury; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Veterans Affairs, a
- 18 leading advocate for "National Spinal Cord Injury Awareness
- 19 Month," offers inpatient, outpatient, home care and respite care
- 20 services as well as specialty health care programs for
- 21 individuals living with a spinal cord injury and facilitates the
- 22 progress of related research through its network of specialized
- 23 care centers and primary care teams; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Buoniconti Fund, in furtherance of its work
- 25 addressing spinal cord injury awareness and its national and
- 26 international objectives related to curing paralysis, is urging
- 27 all individuals in our communities to support its largest
- 28 campaign; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of September
- 30 2019 as "National Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Month" in
