A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of September 2019 as "Preparedness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Senate joins with communities across this
- 4 Commonwealth to raise awareness about an increasingly common
- 5 challenge affecting Pennsylvanians in their homes and places of
- 6 business; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A recent Federal Emergency Management Agency survey
- 8 found that 80% of Americans live in counties that have been hit
- 9 with a weather-related disaster in the past 12 years; and
- 10 WHEREAS, There are many ways for the residents of this
- 11 Commonwealth to raise awareness and take an active role in
- 12 emergency preparedness, including establishing an emergency
- 13 meeting location, stockpiling water, nonperishable foods and
- 14 medicines and becoming CPR certified; and
- 15 WHEREAS, In 2017, nearly 60,000 weather-related events across
- 16 the country cost the lives of 592 Americans and injured 4,270
- 17 others; and

- 1 WHEREAS, During "Preparedness Month," residents of this
- 2 Commonwealth should engage with their families, neighbors and
- 3 friends for emergency action planning and awareness; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Whether currently prepared for an emergency or not,
- 5 all individuals and each household should create a plan, update
- 6 it regularly and periodically practice the plan's execution;
- 7 therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of September
- 9 2019 as "Preparedness Month" in Pennsylvania.
