10	WHEREAS, Catholic elementary and secondary schools educate
11	approximately 137,286 students in this Commonwealth; and
12	WHEREAS, Catholic schools instill in young people a strong
13	foundation of values, self-esteem, self-confidence and
14	leadership skills; and
15	WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with a
16	strong foundation of the values and academic skills needed in
17	becoming responsible residents of this Commonwealth and citizens
18	of this nation, have a drop-out rate of less than 1% and a

postsecondary higher education rate of 96%; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of January 28 through February 3, 2024, as "Catholic Schools Week" in Pennsylvania and express congratulations and appreciation to Catholic elementary and secondary schools across this Commonwealth.
