- 10 WHEREAS, The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics is the
- world's largest organization of food and nutrition professionals 11

- 13 WHEREAS, The majority of the Academy of Nutrition and
- 14 Dietetics' members are Registered Dietitians, Registered
- 15 Dietitian Nutritionists or Registered Dietetic Technicians; and

- 17 celebrating flavors from cultures around the world is a tasty
