Amending the Rules of the Senate, further providing for duties 2 of the President, for the President pro tempore and for voting. 3 RESOLVED, That Rules 3(2), 4 and 20(i) of the Rules of the 4 Senate of Pennsylvania be amended to read: Rule 3. Duties of the President. 7 The President shall: * * * 8 9 While in session have general direction of the Senate Chamber. It shall be the President's duty to preside 10 solely in accordance with these rules. It shall be the 11 12 President's duty to preserve order and decorum, including 13 ensuring all members and staff with privilege of the floor 14 are properly attired pursuant to Senate Rule 10, and, in case 15 of disturbance or disorderly conduct in the Chamber or

galleries, may cause the same to be cleared. When in the

President's opinion there arises a case of extreme

- disturbance or emergency the President shall, with the
- 2 concurrence of the President Pro Tempore, the Majority Leader
- and the Minority Leader, recess the Senate. Such recess shall
- 4 not extend beyond the limitation imposed by Article II,
- 5 section 14 of the Constitution.

- 7 Rule 4. President Pro Tempore.
- 8 (a) Election. -- The Senate shall, at the beginning and close
- 9 of each regular session and at such other times as may be
- 10 necessary, elect one of its Members President Pro Tempore, who
- 11 shall perform the duties of the Lieutenant Governor:
- 12 (1) as set forth in subsection (c);
- 13 <u>(2)</u> in any case of absence or disability of that
- officer[,]; and
- 15 (3) whenever the office of Lieutenant Governor shall be
- vacant. (Const. Art. II, Sec. 9)
- 17 (b) Voting. -- The vote of a majority of the Members voting
- 18 shall be required to elect a President Pro Tempore. Except at
- 19 the beginning and close of each regular session, the Senate
- 20 shall only elect a President Pro Tempore when the office has
- 21 become vacant and the vote of the majority of the Members
- 22 elected shall be required to vacate the office of a seated
- 23 President Pro Tempore.
- 24 (c) Failure to preside in accordance with rules.--If, during
- 25 the course of a legislative day, the President Pro Tempore
- 26 <u>determines that the Lieutenant Governor is not discharging the</u>
- 27 <u>duties under Rule 3(2), the President Pro Tempore shall take</u>
- 28 over the rostrum and perform the duties of the Lieutenant
- 29 Governor for the balance of that legislative day.

- 2 (i) Announcement of vote. -- Upon completion of a roll call
- 3 vote or a voice vote, the result shall be announced immediately
- 4 unless the Majority or Minority Leader requests a delay. <u>If the</u>
- 5 President does not make the announcement of a roll call vote
- 6 under this subsection, the President Pro Tempore shall make the
- 7 announcement upon certification of the vote by the Secretary-
- 8 <u>Parliamentarian</u>.
