9	approximately 141,716 students annually and save State and local

14	WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with a
15	strong foundation of the values and academic skills needed in

of this nation, have a drop-out rate of less than 1% and a postsecondary higher education rate of 97%; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of January 26 through February 1, 2020, as "Catholic Schools Week" in Pennsylvania and express congratulations and appreciation to Catholic elementary and secondary schools across this Commonwealth.
