A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of January 20 through 26, 2020, as "Community Risk Reduction (CRR) Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Studies show most fire-related calls and many
- 4 medical calls for service are preventable; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 2017, an estimated 52% of residential building
- 6 fires were cooking-related, 14% were electrical malfunctions and
- 7 9% were heating-related; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Property damage from fires increased from \$23
- 9 billion in 2017 to nearly \$26 billion in 2018; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It is time again to promote risk reduction in our
- 11 communities along with the Office of the State Fire
- 12 Commissioner; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Residents of this Commonwealth should join the
- 14 Office of the State Fire Commissioner in promoting risk
- 15 reduction in our communities; and
- 16 WHEREAS, "CRR Week" began as a grassroots initiative by fire
- 17 service professionals across the country to raise awareness of
- 18 the importance of risk reduction in the fire service community;

- 2 WHEREAS, "CRR Week" encourages communities to join in a
- 3 variety of CRR programs and activities, making our communities
- 4 safer and reducing the occurrence and impact of emergency events
- 5 for community members and emergency responders; and
- 6 WHEREAS, "CRR Week" events focus on the five E's: Education,
- 7 Engineering, Enforcement, Emergency response and Economic
- 8 incentive; and
- 9 WHEREAS, By identifying and prioritizing risks, and
- 10 concentrating the investment of resources to reduce the
- 11 occurrence and impact of risks, individuals and communities
- 12 across this Commonwealth can "get ahead of the call," ensuring
- 13 that first responders are able to help those most in-need;
