A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of February 24 through 28, 2020, as "Public Schools Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Public education is the foundation of a 21st century
- 4 democracy; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The nation's public schools are where students come
- 6 to be educated as citizens of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, Public schools prepare the nation's young people to
- 8 contribute to the economy, society and citizenry of the country;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ninety percent of American children attend public
- 11 schools; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Federal, state and local lawmakers should prioritize
- 13 support for strengthening the nation's public schools and
- 14 empower local education leaders to implement, manage and lead
- 15 school districts in partnership with educators, parents and
- 16 other local education stakeholders and learning communities; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Federal, state and local lawmakers should support

- 1 such necessities as counseling, extracurricular activities and
- 2 mental health supports that are critical to help students engage
- 3 in learning; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Inclusive and safe high-quality public schools are
- 5 where children learn to think critically, problem-solve and
- 6 build relationships; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Public schools should provide an environment where
- 8 all students can succeed beginning in their earliest years,
- 9 regardless of who they are or where they live; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Efforts should be supported to advance equity and
- 11 excellence in public education and to implement continuous
- 12 improvement and evidence-based practices; and
- 13 WHEREAS, All children have the right to an education that
- 14 helps them to reach their full potential and attend schools that
- 15 offer a high-quality educational experience; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Stable, equitable, predictable and adequate funding
- 17 for great public schools for every student in America is
- 18 necessary to ensure that students have inviting classrooms and
- 19 school libraries with up-to-date resources as well as well-
- 20 prepared and supported educators; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Educators include teachers, paraprofessionals and
- 22 principals who provide a well-rounded and complete curriculum
- 23 and create joy in learning; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The nation's school buildings should have class
- 25 sizes small enough to allow students to receive one-on-one
- 26 attention and access support services such as health care,
- 27 nutrition and after-school programs when needed; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Students, teachers and professionals make the
- 29 nation's public schools vital components of the community; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Parents and communities are working hard to improve

- 1 educational outcomes for children across the country; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The week of February 24 through 28, 2020, is an
- 3 appropriate period to recognize "Public Schools Week"; therefore
