A RESOLUTION

- Designating February 7 through February 14, 2020, as "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week" and further designating February 14, 2020, as "Emersyn's Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week" is an
- 5 annual recognition effort to help educate the public about
- 6 congenital heart defects; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects are the most common
- 8 congenital disability, annually affecting 1 in every 104
- 9 newborns in the United States; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Designating "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week"
- 11 in this Commonwealth promotes greater public awareness about
- 12 congenital heart defects and encourages proper screenings to
- 13 detect such defects; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects are a leading cause of
- 15 birth-defect-related deaths worldwide; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects cause twice as many
- 17 fatalities as childhood cancer; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Newborn screening for congenital heart defects
- 2 involves a simple, noninvasive test called pulse oximetry; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Pulse oximetry screening is the most effective way
- 4 to detect critical congenital heart defects; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Many newborns with a critical heart defect need
- 6 surgery and related procedures during their first year of life
- 7 to repair and sustain their heart; and
- 8 WHEREAS, There continues to be a need for awareness and
- 9 funding to screen for and correct congenital heart defects; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Emersyn Grace was born on March 29, 2018, with a
- 11 heart defect that was detected before her birth and she battled
- 12 through multiple surgeries in her short life; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Though Emersyn tragically passed away in November
- 14 2018 due to complications from her heart condition,
- 15 Pennsylvanians endure with humility to honor her memory by
- 16 spreading awareness for congenital heart defects and the tests
- 17 that can detect them; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of February 7
- 19 through February 14, 2020, as "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness
- 20 Week," and further designate February 14, 2020, as "Emersyn's
- 21 Day" in Pennsylvania.
