A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Terminating the disaster emergency declared in response to the cases of COVID-19 in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority
- 4 of governor) authorizes the Governor to declare a state of
- 5 disaster emergency; and
- 6 WHEREAS, On March 6, 2020, the Governor issued a proclamation
- 7 declaring a disaster emergency in response to the existence of
- 8 COVID-19 cases in Pennsylvania; and
- 9 WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) authorizes the General Assembly
- 10 by concurrent resolution to terminate a state of disaster
- 11 emergency at any time; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, (the House of Representatives concurring) That the
- 13 General Assembly terminate the disaster emergency declared in
- 14 response to the existence of COVID-19 cases in Pennsylvania and
- 15 direct the Governor to issue an executive order or proclamation
- 16 terminating the disaster emergency as required under 35 Pa.C.S.
