## A RESOLUTION

- Designating July 17, 2020, as "Park and Recreation Professionals Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to more than 6,000 local
- 4 parks, 121 State parks, various Federal parks and recreation
- 5 facilities, numerous playgrounds, pools, beaches, campsites,
- 6 marinas, picnic areas, athletic fields, skate parks, dog parks,
- 7 festival venues, gardens, visitor centers, historic and cultural
- 8 attractions and many other recreational facilities and
- 9 amenities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The value and importance that Pennsylvanians place
- 11 on their access to parks and public spaces for their mental and
- 12 physical health during the COVID-19 pandemic are demonstrated by
- 13 a recent 128% increase in mobility to parks; and
- 14 WHEREAS, An April 2020 analysis by George Mason University
- 15 reports that local park and recreation systems in Pennsylvania
- 16 support 14,840 jobs and contribute \$695 million in labor income
- 17 and \$2.28 billion in annual economic activity in the

- 1 Commonwealth; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Park and recreation professionals are supported by
- 3 thousands of volunteers who serve on boards, committees and
- 4 Pennsylvania trails, friends and neighborhood groups; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Park and recreation professionals contribute
- 6 significantly to the health, well-being and quality of life of
- 7 Pennsylvanians of all ages; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Park and recreation professionals bring life-
- 9 enriching services to residents of all ages and abilities, work
- 10 to keep facilities clean, safe and ready to use, strengthen
- 11 community cohesion and resiliency, connect people with nature
- 12 and each other, develop and manage a wide range of public
- 13 programming and provide and promote opportunities for healthy
- 14 living, social equity and environmental sustainability;
- 15 therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate designate July 17, 2020, as "Park
- 17 and Recreation Professionals Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it
- 18 further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Commonwealth celebrate July 17, 2020, by
- 20 extending its thanks and gratitude to park and recreation
- 21 professionals for the indispensable services that they provide
- 22 to our residents and our communities.
