## A RESOLUTION

- Directing the Joint State Government Commission to establish an 1 animal abuse prevention task force to conduct a thorough and 2 comprehensive analysis of laws for the prevention of animal cruelty and abuse and report to the Senate its findings and recommendations. 5 WHEREAS, According to the Humane Society of the United 6 States, intentional cruelty to animals is strongly correlated with other crimes, including violence against people; and 8 9 WHEREAS, On average, 1,920 cases of animal abuse and cruelty 10 are reported each year; and 11 WHEREAS, The Senate recognizes the value of studying this vital issue; therefore be it 12 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate direct the Joint State Government Commission to establish an animal abuse prevention task force of 14 15 20 members; and be it further 16 RESOLVED, That the President pro tempore of the Senate
- 17 appoint two members to the animal abuse prevention task force 18 and the Minority Leader of the Senate appoint two members to the

- 1 animal abuse prevention task force; and be it further
- 2 RESOLVED, That the membership of the animal abuse prevention
- 3 task force be balanced so that it encompasses a wide range of
- 4 backgrounds and viewpoints; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the animal abuse prevention task force contain
- 6 at least one of each of the following individuals:
- 7 (1) a representative from the Governor's Policy Office
- 8 or designee;
- 9 (2) a representative from the Department of Agriculture
- 10 or designee;
- 11 (3) a dog warden;
- 12 (4) an attorney;
- 13 (5) a district attorney;
- 14 (6) a representative from a law enforcement agency;
- 15 (7) a veterinarian;
- 16 (8) a representative from the Humane Society of the
- 17 United States;
- 18 (9) a representative from an animal rescue organization;
- 19 and
- 20 (10) an owner of a large kennel;
- 21 and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission, working
- 23 with the animal abuse prevention task force, conduct a thorough
- 24 and comprehensive analysis of laws throughout the nation for the
- 25 prevention of animal cruelty and abuse; and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission, working
- 27 with the animal abuse prevention task force, identify the best
- 28 preventive practices and develop recommendations; and be it
- 29 further
- 30 RESOLVED, That the final report include recommendations to

- 1 implement necessary changes in State statutes, practices,
- 2 policies and procedures relating to animal cruelty and abuse;
- 3 and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission report
- 5 to the Senate its findings and recommendations no later than 18
- 6 months from the adoption of this resolution.
