## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of April 2019 as "Donate Life Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Organ and tissue transplantation has been recognized
- 4 as a corrective and lifesaving medical procedure; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Each individual who donates organs, eyes and tissues
- 6 can potentially save or enhance more than 75 lives and take 8
- 7 people off the organ transplant waiting list; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It is estimated that more than 113,000 individuals
- 9 are waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant in the United
- 10 States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On average, 20 people die each day in the United
- 12 States waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In 2018, approximately 10,000 individuals in the
- 14 United States, including 615 individuals and families in this
- 15 Commonwealth, elected to support the gift of life through organ
- 16 donation after death; and
- 17 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has 19 transplant centers and is

- 1 recognized as the world leader in organ and tissue
- 2 transplantation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, State law enables citizens to donate their organs
- 4 and tissues through placing the donor designation on their
- 5 driver's licenses or State identification cards and allows
- 6 relatives to consent to the donation of organs and tissues of a
- 7 deceased family member; and
- 8 WHEREAS, A vital component of the continuation and
- 9 advancement of organ transplantation is the recovery of donor
- 10 organs and tissues; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The lifesaving work of transplant team medical
- 12 professionals and researchers to improve techniques and
- 13 antirejection drugs has resulted in a significantly increased
- 14 success rate for organ transplantation; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is a national and international leader
- 16 in the field of donation and transplantation, but the number of
- 17 individuals in need of transplants far exceeds the number of
- 18 organs and the amount of tissue available; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Despite the progress made in the Department of
- 20 Health's Organ and Tissue Donor Awareness program through the
- 21 efforts of the Commonwealth's organ procurement organizations,
- 22 the Gift of Life Donor Program and the Center for Organ Recovery
- 23 and Education (CORE) and their partnering hospitals and
- 24 exceptional health care workers, the growing demand for donated
- 25 organs and tissues for transplantation represents a public
- 26 health issue that merits action; and
- 27 WHEREAS, If this Commonwealth is to remain a leader in organ
- 28 donation and transplantation, it is necessary that the
- 29 pronouncements and public policies of the Commonwealth both
- 30 encourage and promote organ and tissue donation; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of April 2019
- 2 as "Donate Life Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Senate support organ donation and strongly
- 4 encourage all citizens of this Commonwealth to designate
- 5 themselves as an organ and tissue donor on their driver's
- 6 licenses or State identification cards or by registering online
- 7 at www.donatelifepa.org and share the decision to do so with
- 8 their families and friends.
