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# AN ACT

### RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES AND CARRIERS -- PUBLIC TRANSIT AUTHORITY

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 39-18 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Public Transit
- 2 Authority" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 39-18-25. Create parity with MBTA commuter passes.
- 4 The authority shall consult with the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority on the
- 5 <u>feasibility of allowing commuter rail passes to be used on all Rhode Island public transit authority</u>
- 6 buses. These rail passes shall serve as dual Rhode Island public transit authority passes and
- 7 Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority passes, if possible. The consultation shall also include
- 8 proposed methods to apportion and share the costs of the passes between the two (2) authorities.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
