WHEREAS, The Rhode Island Law Enforcement Accreditation Program was established in 2012 and is managed by the Rhode Island Police Accreditation Commission (RIPAC). This program provides the mechanism by which law enforcement agencies can ensure civic leaders and citizens that their departments meet the highest standards, and practice the best methods within the law enforcement profession. The RIPAC program is a rigorous process consisting of 200 standards that address the most important issues facing police departments and law enforcement agencies; and

8 WHEREAS, During a Coventry Town Council meeting that took place on January 28, 9 2019, Coventry Police Chief Colonel John MacDonald delivered the good news to the Coventry community that the Coventry Police Department, for the first time in Department history, had 10 11 earned accreditation from the Rhode Island Police Accreditation Commission. Chief MacDonald 12 stated that attaining accreditation was very difficult and time-consuming and would have been 13 impossible without the countless hours of hard work and tireless devotion provided over the past 14 several years by the Department's Accreditation Managers, Captain Pete Zalabowski and 15 Lieutenant Gary Miller; now, therefore be it
