It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND
2	GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter:
3	CHAPTER 46.1
4	AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDINGS
5	42-46.1-1. Recordings to be made All public bodies within state government and all
6	state public and quasi-public boards, agencies and corporations shall make audio and video
7	recordings of all meetings of the body and shall transmit the recordings of all open meetings
8	within thirty-five (35) days of the meeting to the office of the secretary of state, who shall post
9	the same on its website and make them available to the public in such format or formats as are
10	commonly used for internet transmission; provided that this section shall not apply to public
11	bodies whose responsibilities are solely advisory in nature.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
