It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-19 of the General Laws entitled "Relief of Injured and Deceased
- 2 Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
 - <u>45-19-1.7. Continuation of payment of medical expenses upon retirement. –</u>
- 4 Notwithstanding any provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, any person eligible
- 5 for receipt of pay and benefits pursuant to the provisions of section 45-19-1 who is subsequently
- 6 retired, the respective city, town, fire district, or State of Rhode Island where said person was
- 7 employed shall continue to pay the medical, surgical, dental, optical, or other related expenses for
- 8 treatment including nurses, hospital services, medicines, crutches, and other apparatus.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
