It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-27 of the General Laws entitled "Motor Vehicle Offenses" is

hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

31-27-2.10. Test for impairment or intoxication - Right to use reasonable force. - If

4 a law enforcement officer has reasonable suspicion that a person operated a vehicle which vehicle

5 was involved in an accident resulting in the death or serious bodily injury of another human

being, the law enforcement officer shall require the person to submit to a test of the person's 6

7 bodily fluid for the purpose of determining the alcoholic content thereof and for the presence of

any other potentially impairing substance. The law enforcement officer may use reasonable force

9 if necessary to require the person to submit to the administration of the bodily fluid test. The

10 bodily fluid test shall be performed in a reasonable manner. The testing required pursuant to this

paragraph need not be incidental to a lawful arrest of the person.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

# RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - MOTOR VEHICLE OFFENSES

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1	This act would permit law enforcement officers who have reasonable suspicion that a
2	person who operated a vehicle, which vehicle was involved in an accident resulting in the death
3	or serious bodily injury of another human being, to use reasonable force in requiring the person to
4	submit to a test of bodily fluids. This act would also permit the law enforcement officer to use
5	reasonable force if necessary to require the person to submit to the test.

6 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
