HONORING MARY CAPPELLO ON RECEIVING A GUGGENHEIM FELLOWSHIP

1 WHEREAS, The John Simon Guggenheim fellowship was established by United States Senator and Mrs. Simon Guggenheim in 1925, in memory of their elder son to "add to the 2 3 educational, literary, artistic, and scientific power of this country, and also to provide for the 4 cause of better international understanding"; and 5 WHEREAS, Over the 86 years since its founding, the fellowship has honored 16,000 6 accomplished individuals in the arts and sciences in the United States, Canada, Latin America, and the Caribbean, early or midway through their careers; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Many recipients of the Guggenheim fellowship have gone on to receive other substantial recognition, including more than 100 Nobel prize winners, 32 poets laureate, and 9 10 eight recipients of the Fields International Medal for Outstanding Discoveries in Mathematics; 11 and 12 WHEREAS, This year the Guggenheim fellowship for residents of the United States and 13 Canada was awarded to 180 individuals from more than 3,000 applicants, including Providence 14 resident and University of Rhode Island professor Mary Cappello, who received one of just 13 15 awards given for nonfiction writing; and 16 WHEREAS, Professor Cappello has taught at the University of Rhode Island since 1991, 17 and is the author of four critically acclaimed works of creative nonfiction, Night Bloom: An 18 Italian-American Life; Awkward: A Detour; Called Back: My Reply to Cancer, My Return to 19 Life; and Swallow: Foreign Bodies, Their Ingestion, Inspiration and the Curious Doctor Who 20 Extracted Them; and

1	WHEREAS, Professor Cappello is an important writer and scholar in the field of Italian-
2	American literature, and has also made an important contribution to the cause of breast cancer
3	awareness with her memoir Called Back; and
4	WHEREAS, The awarding of a Guggenheim fellowship to Professor Cappello reflects
5	very positively on the University of Rhode Island, and the system of public higher education in
6	Rhode Island as a whole, which has produced many widely recognized scholars, scientists and
7	artists; now, therefore be it
8	RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
9	Providence Plantations hereby honors Professor Mary Cappello for all she has done to receive the
10	Guggenheim fellowship for creative writing, and extends our deepest appreciation to her for her
11	untiring service to the community as a Professor at the University of Rhode Island for more than
12	two decades and hopefully many years to come. We furthermore wish her well for her
13	forthcoming year of leave as a Guggenheim Fellow during which she plans to write another book
14	and be it further
