It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 4-19 of the General Laws entitled "Animal Care" is hereby amended 2 by adding thereto the following section: 3 4-19-11.4. Use of animals in medical training. 4 (a) An educational program training individuals in the medical treatment of human beings shall not use a live animal in the education or training of students, residents, or physicians if: 5 (1) At least one other accredited training program in the state in the same medical discipline 6 7 does not use live animals; or 8 (2) There is an alternate teaching method that teaches the medical procedure or lesson 9 without the use of an animal. 10 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, 11 and upon conviction shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each animal 12 used. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2026. 13

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMALS AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY -- ANIMAL CARE

l	This act would prohibit a medical training program in this state from using a live animal
2	while teaching medical procedures if at least one other accredited training program in the state in
3	the same medical discipline does not use animals, or there is an alternate teaching method that
1	teaches the medical procedure or lesson without the use of an animal. Violations of this act would
5	be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each animal
5	used.
7	This act would take effect on January 1, 2026.
