1 WHEREAS, It is with deepest sadness that this House of Representatives has learned of 2 the passing of Jocelyn DoCouto, the owner of JaeSlayed/Beatbymaggz Studio in Pawtucket, who 3 was tragically and suddenly murdered as she left the business she had worked so hard to grow, 4 leaving two young children without their mom; and WHEREAS, Jocelyn was a prominent role model throughout her community. Her 5 parents, Adeline Azevedo and Tito DoCouto, and much of her family, had hailed from Senegal 6 7 and Cape Verde. At the age of 11, she had first taught herself how to braid in front of a mirror, and later at the age of 13, she began working in a local barber shop; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Determined to open her own business, Jocelyn started her salon with a 10 cosmetologist as the manager in order to obtain a license, and over the next few years, she 11 championed deregulation of the hair braiding industry; and 12 WHEREAS, Making hair braiding, a generational and practical African-style art-form, 13 into her dream come true, had brought Jocelyn to the State House on many occasions to testify 14 before the legislature, and when the bill subsequently reached the Governor's desk for signing, 15 she was there to celebrate; and WHEREAS, With talent and determination, Jocelyn became not only a successful 16 business owner and hair stylist but expanded as a Digital Creator and Influencer, becoming a 17
