1 WHEREAS, Founded on April 2, 1925, the Rhode Island State Police are responsible for
2 statewide law enforcement and regulation, especially in areas underserved by local police
3 agencies and on the State's limited-access highways; and

4 WHEREAS, The Rhode Island State Police Training Academy, located in Foster, "is
5 designed to challenge each recruit to determine if one possesses the necessary intelligence,
6 emotional stability, physical stamina, and other criteria necessary to meet training objectives and
7 duty requirements of serving with the Rhode Island State Police"; now, therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not
9 otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2024-2025, the sum of one million three hundred eighty
10 thousand dollars (\$1,380,000) to the Rhode Island State Police for the operation of a State Police
11 recruit training academy; and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his
12 orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of said sum, or so much thereof as may be from
13 time to time required, upon receipt of properly authenticated vouchers.
