1 WHEREAS, The heroin crisis that has gripped so many cities and towns in our nation, 2 has caused irreparable harm and grief in the lives of many Americans. Recently, community 3 activists and leaders in Westerly, Rhode Island, and Stonington, Connecticut, have been working tirelessly to combat this deadly epidemic at the local levels; and 4 5 WHEREAS, A nascent movement that began with approximately fifteen members has grown to fifty members through the power of community action and social media. Local residents 6 7 have been volunteering their time, organizing fundraising events and educating the community about the dangers the heroin crisis presents to their community; and 8

9 WHEREAS, On January 17th of 2015, "Shine a Light on Heroin Day" will be 10 commemorated in Westerly and Stonington. Thanks to the support of community volunteers, the 11 local police departments and first responders, and several local businesses, many people will be 12 educated about the danger of heroin to their community, and lives may be saved as a result of 13 these efforts; now, therefore be it

15 hereby proclaims January 17, 2015, to be "Shine a Light on Heroin Day" in Rhode Island.
