It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 13-5 of the General Laws entitled "Station Houses for Women" is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 13-5-11. Availability of feminine hygiene products. (a) Effective January 1, 2022, feminine hygiene products shall be made available to all 4 5 inmates who menstruate at no cost to the inmate. (b) For the purposes of this section, "feminine hygiene products" includes tampons and 6 7 sanitary napkins. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 42-56 of the General Laws entitled "Corrections Department" is 9 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 10 42-56-43. Availability of Feminine hygiene products - department of corrections. 11 (a) Effective January 1, 2022, feminine hygiene products shall be made available to all 12 inmates who menstruate at no cost to the inmate. 13 (b) For the purposes of this section, "feminine hygiene products" includes tampons and 14 sanitary napkins. 15 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
