SENATE RESOLUTION

HONORING THE DISTINGUISHED MUSICAL CAREER AND SERVICE TO RHODE ISLAND BY MR. DAVID GREELY

WHEREAS, At seventeen years of age, David Greely picked up his first fiddle and joined 1 2 the punk bluegrass band, Cornbread, which was subsequently invited to play the New Orleans 3 Jazz and Heritage Festival for six years in a row; and WHEREAS, In 1988, David Greely met Steve Riley and formed the Mamou Playboys, 4 then signed a recording contract with the prestigious Boston-based record label, Rounder 5 Records, and proceeded to play the New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival every year since; and 6 7 WHEREAS, The Mamou Playboys entertained Rhode Islanders at the Cajun and 8 Bluegrass Festival in Escoheag, going on to play many venues over the years in Rhode Island, 9 including Friday night dances at the Holy Ghost Brotherhood Hall, the Big Easy Bash Festival in 10 Escoheag, the Cajun and Zydeco Mardi Gras Ball at Rhodes on the Pawtuxet, the Towers in 11 Narragansett, and the Newport Folk Festival; and 12 WHEREAS, David has performed in Rhode Island with the Mamou Playboys and a 13 variety of side projects well over seventy-five times; and 14 WHEREAS, David, whose love of Cajun music runs deep in his soul, was awarded a 15 Louisiana Folklife Apprentice Grant to study with Cajun Master Fiddler and cultural 16 Ambassador, Dewey Balfa; and 17 WHEREAS, David received the Artist Fellowship in Folklife, Louisiana Division of the 18 Arts, for Lifetime Achievement; and

WHEREAS, David won the Cajun French Music Association award for fiddle player of

1	the year and songwriter of the year for the song "Katherine" in 1996; and
2	WHEREAS, David's song, "Marie Mouri" was recorded by Linda Ronstadt and Ann
3	Savoy on the Grammy-nominated recording, Adieu False Heart; and
4	WHEREAS, The Mamou Playboys have been nominated for two Grammy Awards in
5	The Best Traditional Folk Album category: one Grammy nomination was for Trace of Time and
6	the second was for Bon Rêve; and
7	WHEREAS, David has been instrumental in helping to raise funds at the Mardi Gras Ball
8	for VSA Arts of Rhode Island and stimulating tourism by interpreting traditional Cajun, Blues,
9	Gospel, and Bluegrass music, composing new melodies, and entertaining audiences at venues
10	throughout Rhode Island; now therefore, be it
11	RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations is
12	hereby pleased and honored to congratulate David Greely on his exemplary music career and
13	service to Rhode Island; and be it further
