It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 40-8 of the General Laws entitled "Medical Assistance" is hereby

2 amended by adding thereto the following sections:

3 <u>40-8-20.3. Findings. --</u> The general assembly hereby finds and declares that the oral

4 health of Medicaid-eligible children and adults with disabling conditions in this state is

5 unacceptably poor. Access to dental care statewide is insufficient for these populations. Private

dentists and community clinics who serve Medicaid residents do not receive sufficient

7 <u>reimbursement to cover the costs of care.</u>

8 40-8-20.4. Access to oral healthcare for Medicaid-eligible individuals with disabling

conditions. -- The general assembly directs the department to provide adequate reimbursement

10 for oral health services provided to Medicaid-eligible individuals with developmentally and

11 physically disabling conditions.

12 <u>40-8-20.5. Appropriation. --</u> The general assembly shall annually appropriate to the

department of human services such funds, as it deems necessary, to enable the department to

carry out the purposes of sections 40-8-20.3 and 40-8-20.4.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
