It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-54-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-54 entitled "Physician 2 Assistants" is hereby amended to read as follows: 5-54-9. Criteria for licensure as a physician assistant. -- The board shall recommend to 3 4 the director for licensure as a physician assistant an applicant who: 5 (1) Is of good character and reputation; 6 (2) Graduated from a physician assistant training program certified by the AMA's 7 Committee on Allied Health, Education, and Accreditation, its successor, the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) accreditation review commission 8 9 on education for the physician assistant (ARC-PA) or its successor. 10 (3) Passed a certifying examination approved by the National Commission on 11 Certification of Physician Assistants or any other national certifying exam approved by the board. 12 (4) Submitted a completed application together with the required fee as set forth in 13 section 23-1-54.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
