It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-19 of the General Laws entitled "Relief of Injured and Deceased
2 Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **45-19-1.7. Salary payment of correctional officers.**

4 [Any benefits that a disabled, injured on-duty correctional officer may enjoy, as a result of](#)
5 [any collective bargaining agreement, similar to those benefits available through § 45-19-1, shall](#)
6 [not be subject to any income taxation under chapter 30 of title 44.](#)

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would provide that payments for injuries in the line-of-duty, issued as part of the
2 collective bargaining agreement between the state of Rhode Island and the Rhode Island
3 department of corrections, shall not be subject to taxation under chapter 30 of title 44.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
