RELATING TO INSURANCE -- INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR MENTAL ILLNESS AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27-38.2 of the General Laws entitled "Insurance Coverage for Mental
- 2 Illness and Substance Abuse" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
 - 27-38.2-7. Reimbursement from private insurers.
- Every individual or group health insurance contract, plan, or policy delivered, issued, or
- 5 renewed by an insurer, health maintenance organization, nonprofit or for-profit health service
- 6 corporation on or after January 1, 2024, that provides benefits to individual subscribers and
- 7 members within the state, or to all group members having a principal place of employment within
- 8 the state, shall reimburse child care service providers for therapy services offered through EOHHS
- 9 <u>certified Kids Connect/Therapeutic Childcare Services.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION
