SENATE RESOLUTION

DENOUNCING AND OPPOSING WHITE NATIONALIST AND NEO-NAZI GROUPS

Introduced By: Senator Donna M. Nesselbush

Date Introduced: April 30, 2019

Referred To: Senate Judiciary

1 WHEREAS, White nationalist groups espouse an ideology of white supremacy and the 2 "alleged" inferiority of non-whites. They believe that white identity should be a paramount 3 principle in the governing of western nations and they support non-democratic means to bring this 4 evil philosophy to the forefront; and 5 WHEREAS, The shocking and appalling events that took place on August 12, 2017, in 6 Charlottesville, Virginia, on October 27, 2018, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and on April 27, 7 2019, in Poway, California, confirm that white nationalism and neo-Nazism remain very real 8 threats to social and racial progress; and 9 WHEREAS, Throughout the course of our nation's history, white nationalism has 10 supported and promoted coercion and violent repression of individuals solely on the basis of their 11 race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, and immigration status; and 12 WHEREAS, Today, white nationalism has attempted to reinvent itself, self-identifying as 13 the "alt-right," yet their present-day rhetoric and terrorism conjure painful memories of our 14 nation's past; and 15 WHEREAS, Today, white nationalist and neo-Nazi groups often promote agendas that are in irreconcilable conflict with many of our nation's foundational principles of liberty and 16 justice for all; and 17 18 WHEREAS, White nationalism and neo-Nazism are continuing to grow as menaces to

societal order that seek to reignite social animosities, reverse improvements in race relations,

divide the nation, and foment hatred that leads to ethnic eradication; and

1	WHEREAS, The white nationalists and neo-Nazi message of racial, ethnic, and social
2	intolerance has led to senseless acts of violence that continue to terrorize members of racial and
3	religious minority communities; and
4	WHEREAS, Rhode Island was founded by Roger Williams on the principle of religious
5	tolerance; and
6	WHEREAS, Rhode Island is the home to America's oldest synagogue, the Touro
7	Synagogue, in Newport; now therefore be it
8	RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
9	hereby strongly denounces and opposes the totalitarian impulses, violent terrorism, xenophobic
10	biases, and bigoted ideologies that are promoted by white nationalists and neo-Nazis; and be it
1	further
12	RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to
13	transmit duly certified copies of this resolution to the Honorable Donald J. Trump, President of
14	the United States, the members of the Rhode Island Congressional delegation, and the Honorable
15	Gina M. Raimondo, Governor of the State of Rhode Island.
