Mr. Lopes was a hard-working man who was 5 employed for many years as a supervisor for the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority, where he 6 7 was a member of the notorious group of minority drivers at RIPTA known as the "Sophisticated 8 Gents". He was also the President of the Two Man Union at the 148 Bar & Lounge; and 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Lopes was a dedicated and distinguished public servant who had served 10 with integrity as a member of the Providence City Council, representing the 3rd Ward. He was 11 also a delegate to the Rhode Island Constitutional Convention, and a board member of the 12 Providence Civic Center. In addition, Mr. Lopes had formerly been President of the Rhode Island 13 Seniors Association, was the founding President of S.W.A.P., and a former coach of the 14 Woodlawn Cowboys and the Easton, Massachusetts Wildcats; and 15 WHEREAS, In addition to his wife, Marilyn, Mr. Lopes leaves behind his four children, 16 Lynette Lopes-Mitchell and her husband, Marcus, Chris Lopes and his wife, Maria, Donald Lopes, Jr., and his wife, Lavonne, and Marissa Lopes. He is also survived by his twelve 17 18 grandchildren, Ronald Machado, Chris Lopes, Daniel Lopes, Mason Lopes, Madison Lopes, 19 Lalah Nkomo, Logan Lopes, Morgan Beltre, Zeus Beltre, Marcus Mitchell, Michael Mitchell and 20 Nichole Townsend, and one great-grandchild, Giselle Machado.
