SENATE RESOLUTION

 with various extracurricular activities and volunteering with myriad altruistic community service
 initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Although Katelyn's time with her beloved husband was sadly short, their love was joyous and brought her an immeasurable abundance of happiness.
