It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:
SECTION 1. Sections 24-10-17 and 24-10-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 24-10 entitled "Freeways" are hereby amended to read as follows:

## 24-10-17. Soliciting rides in motor vehicles.

(a) Any person who endeavors by words, gestures, or otherwise to beg, invite, or secure transportation in any motor vehicle on any freeway within the state, except in the case of a bona fide emergency or in the case of sickness, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.
(b) Any person who endeavors to solicit a ride in a motor vehicle in the manner described in this section on the traveled portion of any other public highway in this state shall be gutily of a misdemeanor. Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.

## 24-10-18. Backing up prohibited.

Any person who backs up a motor vehicle on a roadway or shoulder of any freeway within the state, shall be guilty of a misdemeaner. Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.

SECTION 2. Section 31-41.1-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-41.1 entitled "Adjudication of Traffic Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 31-41.1-4. Schedule of violations.

(a) The penalties for violations of the enumerated sections, listed in numerical order, correspond to the fines described. However, those offenses for which punishments may vary

1 according to the severity of the offense, or punishment that require the violator to perform a
2 service, shall be heard and decided by the traffic tribunal or municipal court. The following 3 violations may be handled administratively through the method prescribed in this chapter. This 4 list is not exclusive and jurisdiction may be conferred on the traffic tribunal with regard to other 5 violations.

(b) In addition to any other penalties provided by law, a judge may impose the following penalties for speeding:
(1) For speeds up to and including ten miles per hour ( 10 mph ) over the posted speed limit on public highways, a fine as provided for in subsection (a) of this section for the first offense; ten dollars (\$10.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the second offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense; and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the third and any subsequent offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to thirty (30) days.
(2) For speeds in excess of ten miles per hour ( 10 mph ) over the posted speed limit on public highways, a mandatory fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each mile over the speed limit for the first offense; fifteen dollars $(\$ 15.00)$ per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the second offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense; and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the third and subsequent offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to sixty (60) days.
(c) Except for a technology surcharge assessed in accordance with § 8-15-11, any person charged with a violation who pays the fine administratively pursuant to this chapter shall not be subject to any additional costs or assessments, including, but not limited to, the hearing fee established in § 8-18-4.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.

#### Abstract

***

This act would eliminate the provision a person who solicits a ride in a motor vehicle or backs up a motor vehicle on a freeway is guilty of a misdemeanor. This act would also amend the schedule of violations to include the one hundred dollar (\$100) fine for the advertising of motor vehicles for sale on state highways.

This act would take effect upon passage
