- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain outdated and unnecessary provisions
- 2 regarding certain child support obligations and medical services to the indigent.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 25-7-6.8 be repealed.
- 5 <u>25-7-6.8. The schedule in § 25-7-6.2 shall be used to set child support obligations, and shall</u>
- 6 be applied regardless of the sex of the obligor.
- 7 Section 2. That § 25-7-21 be repealed.
- 8 <u>25-7-21. In any prosecution under §§ 25-7-16 to 25-7-20, inclusive, it shall be competent</u>
- 9 for the people to prove nonaccess of husband to wife or any other fact establishing nonpaternity
- 10 of a husband.
- 11 Section 3. That § 28-6-4.6 be repealed.
- 12 28-6-4.6. Reimbursement for chiropractic services shall be limited to the practice of
- 13 chiropractic services as defined as reimbursable charges to Title XIX. For the purposes of this
- 14 chapter, the term chiropractic means a chiropractor as defined by § 36-5-1 and also an individual
- 15 licensed to practice chiropractic under the laws of another state.
