

2023 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1057

1 An Act to allow for the appointment of county coroner by all counties.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 7-7-1.4 be AMENDED:

7-7-1.4. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 7-7-1.1, the board of county
commissioners in any county-with a population of sixty thousand or more may, by
resolution, appoint a coroner who shall serve at the pleasure of such board. However, no
board of county commissioners may exercise the authority granted pursuant to this
section unless:

- 9 (1) Not later than the April first preceding the election for coroner, the board, by 10 resolution, adopts the appointment option; and
- (2) The appointment of any appointed coroner may not take effect until the expiration
 of the term of office of any duly elected coroner.
