1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to correct a definition in the Uniform Unsworn Domestic
2 Declarations Act.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 18-7-2 be amended to read:

5 18-7-2. The terms in this chapter mean:

- 6 (1) "Boundaries of the United States," the geographic boundaries of the United States,
7 Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, and any territory or insular possession
8 subject to the jurisdiction of the United States;
- 9 (2) "Law," includes a statute, judicial decision or order, rule of court, executive order,
10 and administrative rule, regulation, or order;
- 11 (3) "Record," information that is inscribed on a tangible medium or that is stored in an
12 electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable form;
- 13 (4) "Sign," with present intent to authenticate or adopt a record ~~to execute or adopt a~~
14 ~~record:~~



- 1 (a) To execute or adopt a tangible symbol; or
- 2 (b) To attach to or logically associate with the record an electronic symbol, sound,
- 3 or process;
- 4 (5) "Sworn declaration," a declaration in a signed record given under oath. The term
- 5 includes a sworn statement, verification, certificate, and affidavit;
- 6 (6) "Unsworn declaration," a declaration in a signed record not given under oath but is
- 7 given under penalty of perjury.
